





Let's be clear about one thing: People are not always going to believe or understand your story. They don't get how you keep going. They don't get how you survive being despised. They don't get how you can keep loving through being disliked, abused, overlooked, ignored, and sometimes even hated. They don't get what you mean when you tell your testimony that you stopped whoring, drugging, and drinking, because of an encounter with an unseen Savior.

If you are going to follow Jesus, and tell your story, get ready for rejection and disbelief adjustments with friends, colleagues, family members, and enemies. You just need to know that because you said it, doesn't mean they will believe it. Here are words you are subject to hear returned to you, so be prepared:

- 1. It won't last- you're going through a phase.
- 2. It won't come to pass- You're being brainwashed.
- 3. You think you're better than us, don't you?

In John 10 Jesus begins to share with others that the path to "The Father" was through Him. The listeners didn't understand He attempted further and they responded with mixed opinions, many even saying of Him, "He has a devil and is mad (crazy), why should we listen to Him?"

That said, here is what you should know about your journey:

- A) Rejection may come
- B) Abandonment may follow




Bridging the gap is about changing the mindset from what one was traditionally taught and being open to hearing and listening to the viewpoint of others. It is about recognizing that our differences should not separate and divide us but brings us together by understanding, that not one individual has a monopoly over others. Whether young or old, literate or illiterate, professional or non-professional, unsaved or saved the perspective of one another should be communicated and respected regardless of our differences. If we desired to be successful in every aspect or area of life, then there must be a transformation in the mindset and a willingness to bring about that change with positivity instead of negativity. We have a responsibility to the next generation of ensuring that they are successful in the secular world and the life of the Church. Therefore, unity must be built on using God's word, wisdom, knowledge, and understanding which are foundation and pillars that solidify the bridge. The responsibility lies with the mature and newer generation's willingness to "Bridge the Gap". This will require both generations to give and receive from each other. So, what recourse can we take to fill in the breach among the mature and newer generation? Let us consider the Bible:

Throughout biblical history, children were depicted as second-class citizens. The right of children was still often overlooked, and little thought was given to them.

Je However, Jesus' perspective changes the dynamic as it relates to the treatment of children among His contemporaries. For He said, "Let the children come to me, and do not stop them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to them". With this one sentence, Jesus portrays the characteristics of the kingdom of God using children. While young people were thought to be insignificant in the eyes of adults; they were important to God and held a very special place in Jesus' heart. Jesus saw these little ones' humbleness, vulnerability, and innocence that the His contemporaries could not see.

And perhaps, the children saw in Jesus the comfort and peace, and gentleness in his voice as He spoke words that even they could understand. Maybe, they saw an adult whose personality and warmth drew them like a moth to light; instead of cold and judgmental. For Jesus saw the children, embraced them, and loved them. Jesus' Words spoke volumes then and are still ringing loud and clear today. "Let the children come to me and do not stop them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to them." The question is: Do we "see them," "embrace them," and "love them?" These are the layers that will fill in the gap. This is how to build the kingdom of God; bridging the gap between the generations of today and the future.

### MILK TO MEAT

Both are processes of growth, always striving to move from one level to another in this Christian walk.

Both are a part of a process called growth: always striving to move from one level to another as we journey along this Christian walk. The lack of either could be damaging to kingdom work.

#### 1 Corinthians 3:1-5

"And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able. For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal and walk as men? For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal? Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?

The second verse speaks of the immaturity of some of the people of God. In this passage Apostle Paul states "I have fed you with milk and not meat: for hitherto you were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able"

He speaks about the inability to know the real truth and put it into practice. Many have been in the Church for many years, yet still refuse to practice "real" regardless of how many times they've experienced the preached word or have been taught because the mind is still carnal. You must desire the sincere milk of the Word, that ye may grow thereby.

Search the scriptures: Hebrews 5:12-14

"For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskillful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

God wants us to mature in Him and in the knowledge of His Word; therefore, experiencing progressive movement, as we serve a God who is progressive and not stagnant. The will of God is that we all be on One Accord.










# PROPHETIC REVELATIONS CONCERNING ENDTIME REVIVAL
