#### MINISTRY IN THE HERE AND NOW

Ministry (sharing the good news) has not changed in location and focus since the time of Jesus. The capacity to share has exponentially increased. Paul preached in the synagogue, the brick-and-mortar location. He had good news for those who were religious and needed salvation. He had to reach beyond those who were coming inside the synagogue to expand their knowledge. Paul went into the streets to speak with anyone that would listen. He sent letters to be shared. He shared in prison and on the side of the road. With the state of the world, our spirit should be as Paul's was, stirred up to reach the lost, initiate a relationship, change venues, and accept whomever the Lord brings into our path for ministry.

What areas are open for ministry that are different from your grandparent's experiences as believers? We are familiar with the annual summer revivals, including tents, which were portable to travel during the summer. There were also street ministers on rare occasions. The focused ministry occurred in a designated building, the traditional inperson Sunday morning service, evening worship, church school, and evening training programs. When posing the question, "Where is the most common place to hear God's word", among today's individuals, the answers varied. Because of the advancement in technology, many ministries are taking advantage of the opportunity to share their messages over platforms that allow them to reach audiences on a global spectrum. Rather than seeking God at an actual church location, participants reported that they now look to social spiritual media and other platforms for encouragement and fulfillment. For example, ondemand streaming TV network platforms and social media, accessed from their phones and other smart devices, YouTube, Blogs, Podcasts, and Web TV were some of their responses.






Reaching the masses with the word of God seems to require going outside of the walls of the building.





I have not accomplished this of my abilities, it is the grace and mercy of God. The good news is also available to you. God has given us the perfect recipe for success in His Word:



### IT IS HARVEST TIME

### Ripe For Picking

Jesus said, "...You know the saying, four months between planting and harvest," But I say, wake up and look around. The fields are ripe for harvest" (John 4:35)

I think the greatest expectation of sowing seeds is the Sower's expectation of Harvest Time and the hope of gathering a bountiful crop.

When I was a little girl, I can remember my father plowing the fields in which his garden would grow. I watched as he walked behind his plow tilling the soil from one end of the field to the other, row after row. I was amazed that he not only knew what to plant but understood the timing to plant, as well. He would sow rows of corn, cabbages, and tomato, sweet potatoes. white potato, turnips greens, butter beans, lima beans, green beans, watermelons, etc. He'd wait with patience for them to burst forth from the hard outer core and begin the germination process of budding tender leaves until they reached maturity. And when the crops were ripe for the picking, there was the harvest.

As I reflected on the memory of my father during this season of gathering crops, I was reminded of a passage of scripture about Jesus speaking to his Disciples concerning the harvest. In John 4:35 Jesus said these words, "don't you have a saying, It's still four months until harvest? But I say, wake up and look around. The fields are ripe for harvest." In other words, we must open our eyes to a spiritual truth: The Church does not need to wait for the harvest. From Jesus' perspective, the harvest is waiting for the Church, and the time is ripe for picking. There are fields of spiritually unsaved individuals that need to hear the gospel of Jesus Christ and His salvation plan and purpose for them here and now!



## SEED TIME & HARVEST TIME

What is Seedtime and harvest and who came up with this principle? That's a great question.

The answer to that question is found in Genesis 8:22. God said, after He had flooded the earth and the water had subsided, "While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter and day and night shall not cease." In other words, this principle will be in effect while the earth remains. This principle affects everything we think, do, or say.

For the farmer, seedtime is the time you plant seeds, and the harvest is when you gather what was planted from the seed that was sown. Once planted, the seed begins to sprout in the ground, develop roots and grow so that in the final stage the seed produces a crop that the farmer can now harvest or gather.

Well, how does this principle affect you and me? The things we do, our actions; the things we think, our thoughts; or the things we say, our words; are like a seed ready to be planted. These can produce detrimental, harmful, or beneficial results. Our thoughts can either tear us down or lift us up. Proverbs 23:7 states, "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he." We are told in Philippians 4:8 to think about things which are true, noble, just, pure, lovely, and of good report, so that the Peace of God will be with you.

The Israelites were not able to enter the land of Canaan under the leadership of Moses because of the things that they said. Their words were like seeds planted, words of doom, doubt, and destruction. Therefore, they experienced wandering in the wilderness until every one of those who murmured died and the harvest they reaped was not being able to see the fulfillment of God's promise. Joshua and Caleb were able to see and entered the promised land because they spoke words of faith. Proverbs 18:21 states that "Death and life are in the power of the tongue and they that love it will eat its fruit."





The principle of seedtime and harvest is also manifested in our behavior, and how we treat others. Jesus said in Matthew 7:12, "do unto others that you would want them to do unto you." Remember that God is not mocked whatever a man sows, he will also reap.

The principle of seed time and harvest also applies to our finances. 2 Corinthians 9:6.7 says, "a stingy sower will reap a meager harvest, but a generous spirit will reap an abundant harvest." Let giving flow from your heart, not from a sense of religious duty. Give with joy because God loves a cheerful giver. Jesus said in Luke 6:38, "give and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be given back to you."

The harvest that we reap is determined by the seed that we sow.





### THE BLESSING OF

No matter what is going on, the Bible states that there will always be a seedtime and a harvest (Gen. 8:22). If there is a time of sowing, then there must be a time of reaping or harvest. Harvest time represents a time of gathering something that you have been hoping or planning for. Whatever it is that you are desiring, usually there is a plan put in place to begin the process of receiving it. Once the plan is developed, then comes the time to plant the idea (or the aspects of the dream you had earlier envisioned) and from there, a moment of expectation.

Expectation of a Harvest: something you have been hoping for that brings new excitement. That new excitement is connected to the understanding that what was in a seed or developmental stage, now has the capability of producing something that, when the process is completed, will bring forth a never-before-experienced satisfaction and appreciation.

Whenever you see the phrase "seedtime and harvest" we need to break it down into three separate meanings to receive the gist of its true understanding. Seed, Time, and Harvest when separated allow us to get a clearer picture of its total components. The word "Seed" is associated with expectation as we mentioned before.

Time, when separated denotes that once the seed has been sown, then we enter a season of rest. During this season of rest, the seed is growing and developing into the culmination of what we were hoping for in the beginning. It is important to note that in this phase of "Time", what the seed becomes when it leaves us is now in God's control. Will it produce more or less than our expectation? The answer to that assumption, for those of us who are believers in God, lies in the strength of our faith.

Faith is the substance behind what we are hoping for or are expecting when there is no evidence. If our faith is strong, then we understand that no matter what transpires during the process, everything will work together for our good! You see, the blessing in the Harvest guarantees the revelation that no matter what was sown, it will always produce more than we had in the beginning. Here's how it works.
